

QT1: **Where** is/? **Who** is?

The answer is in the text - restate in your own words

QT2: **How** does....feel?



Text detective!

- Identify character's feelings
- Either author tells us or imagine how you'd feel
- SAY how character feels

QT3: **Do you** think....?



Judge and jury!

- Personal opinion (in your head)
- Support with evidence (from the text)

QT4: **What** does....**mean** when?



Text detective!

- Explain a word/phrase
- Usually metaphor/figure of speech Explain the metaphor

QT5: **Put**....in **order**



Text detective!

- Structure/sequence
- Scan and mark text by numbering events as they appear in the text

QT6: **List**



Text detective!

- Scan text
- Identify all information linked to a similar theme

QT7: **Who** has **written** this?



Text detective!

- Look for text clues
- First person- I
- Third person- he/she Signed/name

QT8: **Contrast** two different situations



Text detective!

- Describe the first
- Describe the second Say how they are different

QT9: **Where** might this have been **published**?  
**Why** is the **author** writing this?



Text detective!

- Reason for writing?
- Style of layout?
- Style of writing?
- Apply clues you know about texts

QT10: **Why** is.....written in this way?



Judge and jury!

- Features of presentation
- What is the effect of writing it like this?

QT11: **Which** piece of writing did **you** think was more effective / like more?



Judge and jury!

- Contrast 2 styles
- Personal opinion supported by evidence
- Summarise both styles Quite/refer to both pieces in the text

QT12: **Predict**.  
**What do you** think? **Why**?
